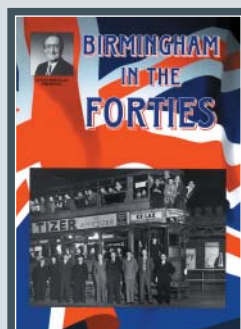
Alton Douglas is well known for his popular pictorial histories of the Midlands and sales of his books have now reached over 450,000 copies making him the Midlands' best selling local author.
